OGHA RETURN TO HOCKEY PROTOCOLS

Protocols for all entering the arena

- Before entering the arena ALL participants, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers MUST fill in the online COVID-19 Health Screening Form associated with their team, located under the COVID-19 tab on the Tigers website. This MUST be done every time you come to the arena.
- All participants, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers are required to wear face masks/coverings that securely cover the nose, mouth and chin at all times while in the arena.
- Participants are to wear their mask until their activity begins. At that time masks can be removed and masks donned again right after play.
- Main entrances will be used for entering and exiting Alder Recreational Sports Centre and Tony Rose Memorial Sports Centre.
- Loitering in common areas is not permitted.
- Physical distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) is required at all times while in the facility.
- All team Screeners must arrive 30 minutes prior to the scheduled activity time and be at the check in table for the team to enter.
- All participants, coaches and parents/guardians will be allowed to enter the arena no earlier than 20 minutes prior to their ice time and vacate no more than 20 minutes after their booked time.
- All participants are encouraged to arrive fully dressed, however, due to weather they may arrive at the arena with their bottom half on (jill, shin guards, socks & pants) in order to wear coats. Participants will have 20 minutes to finish dressing and enter the ice.
- Change rooms will be open with limited space for U11 and older teams. The door will remain open and masks must be worn in the change room at all times. Only players are allowed in change rooms if space allows, NO PARENTS OR SIBLINGS. Additional chairs/seating will be available for tying skates.
- Upon arrival ALL participants, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers MUST sanitize and check in at the OGHA sign in table located inside the arena doors. You must provide your name and contact information for tracking purposes.
- All participants must bring their own prefilled water bottles.



Protocols for game play with visiting teams

- ALL participants, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers from both teams MUST fill in the online COVID-19 Health Screening Form associated with the Orangeville team, located under the COVID-19 tab on the Tigers website.
- Upon arrival ALL participants, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers from both teams MUST sanitize and check in at the sign in table located inside the arena doors. You must provide your name and contact information for tracking purposes.
- Referees and time keepers MUST fill in the online COVID-19 Health Screening Form on the Tigers website and check in with the screener at the OGHA table.
- Visiting teams will follow all protocols outlined in this document for entering and exiting the facilities.
- Change rooms will be open with limited space for U11 and older teams. The door will remain open and masks must be worn in the change room at all times. Only players are allowed in change rooms if space allows, NO PARENTS OR SIBLINGS. Additional chairs/seating will be available for tying skates.
- Warm-ups will not be allowed inside the facility or anywhere off the ice surface.
