OGHA RETURN TO HOCKEY PROTOCOLS

Protocols for all entering the arena

- Before entering the arena ALL players, staff and parents MUST fill in the online COVID-19 Health Screening Form associated with their team, located under the COVID-19 tab on the Tigers website
- Only 1 parent per family allowed in the arena at this time. No siblings
- All players must arrive at the arena fully dressed with the exception of skates
- All players, staff and parents MUST enter the arena no earlier than 20 minutes and no later than 10 minutes before their ice time to avoid overlap. If outside of these times you may not be permitted to enter
- Masks must be worn at all times inside of the arena unless on the ice. Participants will remove their mask when they put their helmet on
- Upon arrival ALL players, staff and parents MUST sanitize and check in at the sign in table located just inside the arena doors. You must provide your name and contact information for tracking purposes
- When entering red rink, you will enter through the red rink South fire doors

Protocols once in the arena

- Players will move to either Group 1 (located down the change room hall) or Group 2 (located under the time clock) and sit in a chair
- Group 1 will enter and exit the ice from the Home bench
- Group 2 will enter and exit the ice from the corner door under the clock
- Parents will proceed to the stairs in Group 1 (beside Zamboni) or Group 2 (near time clock) and stand at the top of the bleachers. There are markings on the ground and physical distancing is mandatory
- Change rooms are closed at this time. 1 room will be open for emergency first aid only
- A washroom is located upstairs in red rink
- No one is allowed in the lobby



Protocols when on the ice for development

- Physical distancing must be exercised at all times
- Coaches are encouraged to remain in one spot
- Coaches cannot skate along side players or touch them in any way
- Players must not touch each other
- Players must not share water bottles
- Players must bring their own tissues and a bag to put used ones in. Used tissues must be taken home to be disposed of
- Only 1 person is responsible for picking up pucks

Protocols when on the ice for modified game play

Protocols when exiting the arena

- Parents must come down the same set of stairs they entered from
- Players will only take skates off and leave fully dressed
- Everyone will exit the building through the door located beside the Zamboni door in red rink
- Everyone must exit the building within 10 minutes after leaving the ice
- Group 2 must not exit until the hallway is clear of Group 1 participants
