




FUNdamentals (2016 & 2017 Birth Years)

- **CROSS-ICE** games
- Small nets
- Blue pucks
- No goalies
- Games
 - ✓ Game length: 2 periods X 18 minutes
 - ✓ Shift length of 3 minutes (running time)
 - ✓ Buzzer to change shifts
 - ✓ 4-on-4
 - ✓ No score kept
 - ✓ **No referees**; coaches on the ice to assist with positioning and shift changes
 - ✓ Face-off to begin the game, but a live puck during shift changes
 - ✓ Upon a goal being scored, scoring team backs off to half and opposing team bring the puck up the ice
 - ✓ During games, players not playing will participate in skills stations in the middle section of the ice
- Teams will play two 36-minute games in one ice session
- 4 teams will be on the ice during one ice session

U7 (2015 Birth Year)

- CROSS-ICE games
- Small nets
- Blue pucks
- No goalies
- Games
 - ✓ Game length: 2 periods X 18 minutes
 - ✓ Shift length of 3 minutes (running time)
 - ✓ Buzzer to change shifts
 - ✓ 4-on-4
 - √ No score kept
 - ✓ No referees; coaches on the ice to assist with positioning and shift changes
 - ✓ Face-off to begin the game, but a live puck during shift changes
 - ✓ Upon a goal being scored, scoring team backs off to half and opposing team bring the puck up the ice
 - ✓ During games, players not playing will participate in skills stations in the middle section of the ice
- Teams will play two 36-minute games in one ice session
- 4 teams will be on the ice during one ice session





U8 (2014 Birth Year ONLY)

- HALF-ICE games
- Medium nets (4.5' wide X 3' tall)
- Blue Pucks
- Goalies
- Games
 - ✓ Game length: 2 periods X 18 minutes
 - ✓ Shift length of 2 minutes (running time)
 - ✓ Buzzer to change shifts
 - √ 4-on-4 (+ goalies)
 - ✓ No score kept
 - ✓ **No referees**; one coach per team on the ice to assist with positioning and shift changes
 - ✓ Face-off to begin the game, but a live puck during shift changes
 - ✓ Upon a goal being scored, scoring team backs off to half and opposing team bring the puck up the ice
- Due to the rink divider set up, teams may use the bench and/or the penalty box for players who are not on the current shift
- Teams will play two 36-minute games in one ice session
- 4 teams will be on the ice during one ice session

U9 (2013/2014 Birth Years, or 2013s ONLY)

- FULL-ICE games
- Regulation nets
- Black Pucks
- Goalies
- Games
 - ✓ Game length: 3 periods X 10-10-12 minutes
 - √ No score kept
 - ✓ Referees
- No playoffs
